
Emissions targets


2018 – 2022

2018 – 2022








Over half of the reduction in emissions attributable to active reduction measures



Flaring and venting reduction


2018 – 2022

UK Emissions Trading Scheme UK vs EU




The UK trading at a significant discount to EU ETS make decarbonisation projects more challenging




Accelerated energy decline
